Endorsed by the Rutgers Cleveland Clinic Consortium of Armed Forces Institute for Regenerative Medicine (RCCC-AFIRM) this event draws more than 100 of the leading experts in skin healing and transdermal drug delivery.

The workshop focused on skin reconstruction for wounds, burns and deep skin trauma and brought together leading clinician-researchers, government scientists and industrial technology directors to share their approaches to the challenges of this theme. Students and young investigators had a special opportunity to meet these research leaders and to expand their future horizons.

Our panelists discussed current issues in skin including unmet medical needs, existing limitations and technology gaps, and quality of life for recipients of both artificial and cadaver skin products.

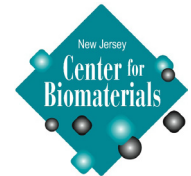

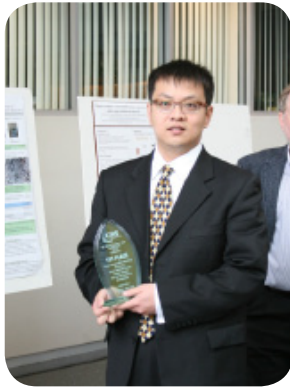
