

DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER AUTHORS

Deadline for abstract for poster submission - July 1st, 2014

Submissions must include the title, authors, affiliations, and a short abstract. Papers must be submitted in PDF format less than 4MB in size, and must fit on a single letter sized page. All submittals must be sent to symposium@dls.rutgers.edu with the following subject line: **2014 Symposium Call for Posters**

Authors are responsible for obtaining appropriate clearances. Final submissions must be in camera-ready PDF. Authors of accepted abstracts must register for the conference by **August 1** to guarantee that their place will be held. Accepted abstracts will appear in the electronic Symposium proceedings.

Abstract Preparation

1. The abstract must not exceed the following limits:

- Limit to one 8.5" X 11" page
- Page margins: Top = 1"; Bottom = 0.5"; Left and Right = 0.5"

2. Abstract title must be in 14pt Times New Roman, Title Case (Upper and Lower Case), italicized, left-justified.

3. The Authors' names and affiliations must be in 10pt Arial, bold, right-justified. Presenting author is indicated by an underline. All other co-authors are not underlined. Use surname followed by initials (e.g. Smith, B.). Affiliations must indicate institution, city, state, and country. Do not include degrees or professional titles (e.g. Dr., Prof., etc.). Authors on several abstracts should ensure that their names and affiliations are consistent across the different submissions.

4. If there is more than one author/affiliation, superscript numbers should be used to indicate the affiliation. Take a new line for the authors' affiliations and number each one starting with 1 for the first. Example:

Smith, J. R.¹, Jones, P.², Brown, R.¹
1 University of Sydney, Sydney, NSW, Australia
2 Stanford University, Palo Alto, CA, USA

5. Insert one line between the list of author/s and the abstract body.

6. Abstract text must be in 12pt Times New Roman, left-justified, single-spaced.

7. Subtitles may be used (e.g. Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, References). Leave a line between sections but do not indent.

8. Pictures, tables, and graphs may be included within the limits specified. Ensure that any figures/tables/graphs are within the printable area of the page. The conversion of your word file to a pdf file may result in omission of images if they are not within the printable area of the page.

9. Use standard abbreviations only. Within the body of the abstract, when using abbreviations, spell out the name in full at the first mention and follow with the abbreviation in parentheses. Abbreviations may be used in the title, provided the name in full is outlined in the body of the abstract.
